Mr. Fontes – Water & Sewer

- Recommended canceling the July 4th meeting since most would be out of town. Council Agreed.
- Read a letter that was in the Nassau County Record stating how upsetting it was that the Cheerleaders are the only ones recognized on the sign when so many other students have done great things.
- Mrs. Smith stated after this whole deal with the Cheerleaders not liking the sign that starting next year the only thing on the sign should be "Home of the West Nassau Warriors". This way it covers every group, and no one can be upset. Council Agreed.

- Reported that the officer has been doing the extra coverage, and has written seven tickets.
- Council Consensus was to continue the extra coverage until school lets out for summer and then revisit the matter.

Mr. Mellecker – Zoning

- Planning & Zoning is almost done with Revisions of Chapter 195 & will send it back to the Council for approval.
- Stated that Mr. Larsen is too busy and we need to look for someone else to do inspections. Mr. Garver could handle the residential, but we would need to find someone for the Commercial.
 - Mr. Fontes recommended possibly contracting the County person to handle Commercial. Mr. Williams stated they are already undermanned, but that he would look into it.

- Council Consensus is to watch the Webinar in the Council Chambers on April 2nd at 10:00 AM.
- National Day of Prayer Thursday, May 5th. Asked the Council about having it at the Fire Station due to the Park construction and rain. Council Agreed.

- Read letter received from Mrs. Prestwood from Branch Creek Subdivision HOA stating they
 would no longer be paying the lights after April 5th.
 - o Asked Council how to respond.
 - Mr. Branham stated a response was sent to Mr. Greene about that awhile back, and the Town will not be taking that over.

- Stated he was excited about the new Sheik Restaurant coming in and hopes more businesses will follow.
- Stated they are working on new equipment and updating certifications at the Fire Station.
